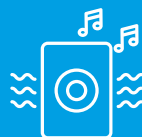

It will carry news items, small videos (not longer than one and a half minutes) and news from settlement residents. The district has no radio or TV station covering the whole territory of Taimyr. The State Television and Radio Company does broadcast in the ethnic languages, but in Dudinka only.

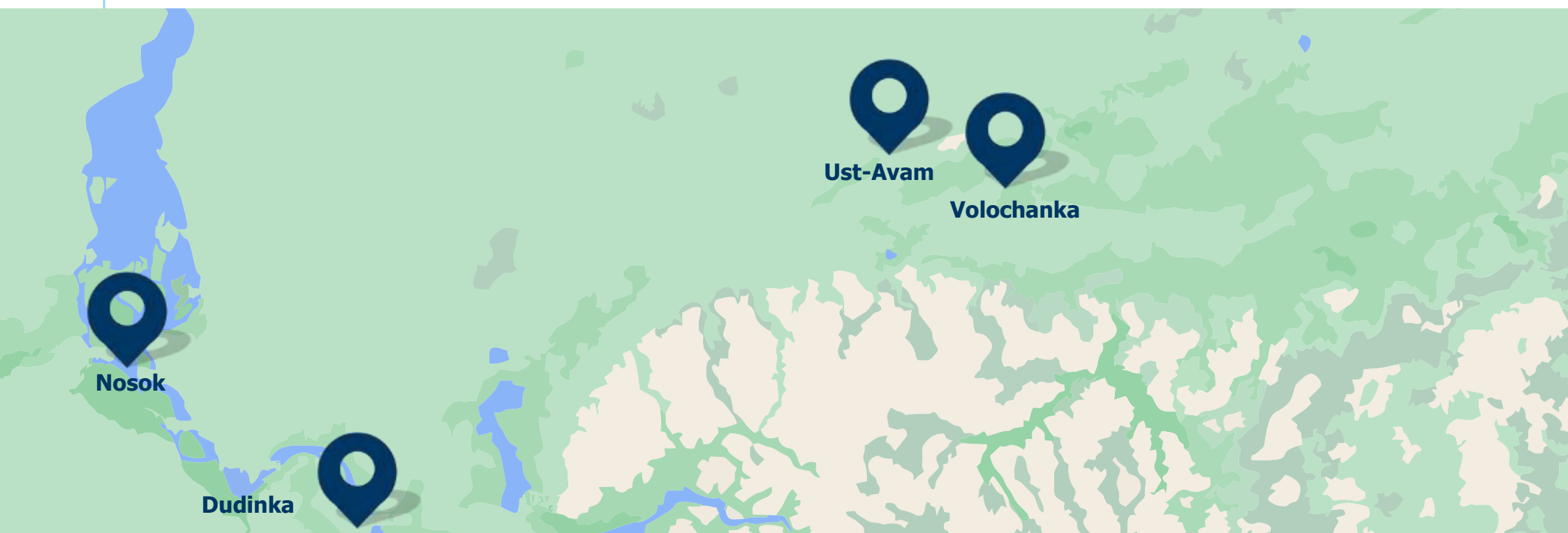
